### **TCCA Sanctioned – Double Show – Saturday, September 13**

**PLEASE NOTE: Exhibitors do not need to be TCCA members to compete in the show.**

- 1a. The Junior Shows are open to Texas 4 – H and FFA members with registered Beef Heifer projects.  
**No out of state exhibitor/heifer will be allowed to show.**
- 1b. No unregistered or crossbred heifer may be entered. All heifers must be registered in the herdbook of their respective breed Association and must be considered a purebred heifer by that Association.
2. Entries are subject to the Washington County Fair Association, General Rules and Regulations and all show rules and Code of Show Ring Ethics, and the Texas Animal Health Commission.
3. **Health papers are required. Health paper is a general health certificate and must include the following: I.D. number of animal and statement of freedom from fevers and diseases.**
- 3a. Entry cards and fees are due in the Fair Office by **September 1**. Entry fees are \$25.00 per heifer for Show A; \$15.00 per heifer for Show B. **Entry fees are non-refundable.**
- 3b. Late entries will be accepted at time of check-in on September 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>. A late fee of \$10.00 will be charged per heifer, per show.
4. **STALLING:** No pre-stalling of animals. (However, the show superintendent reserves the right to limit stall space to any exhibitor, 4-H Club or FFA Chapter.) **NO CATTLE TRIM CHUTES ALLOWED IN THE STALLING AREA OR IN THE BARN ISLES. CATTLE TRIM CHUTES MUST REMAIN OUTSIDE THE BARN.**
5. All exhibitors will receive one (1) gate pass and one (1) parking pass. A \$10.00 gate pass fee will be charged for all non-exhibitors. (Gate passes will be honored Friday and Saturday.) **NO EXTRA PARKING PASSES WILL BE SOLD.**
- 5a **All trailers must be parked off of the Washington County Fairgrounds. A trailer parking lot will be available at a location off of the fairgrounds.**
6. No shavings allowed in barn. All heifers will be stalled on sand.

- 7b. All heifers must be registered in the name of the exhibitor (no joint ownership). Original registration paper **must be** presented at time of check-in. No bill of sale, no pending papers and no applications for transfer or Xerox copies of papers. Only fax copies from Breed Association verifying ownership will be accepted. Fax copy must have name of breed association.

7c. Scramble Heifers: copies of scramble heifer papers will be accepted, providing an official certificate from the Scramble Sponsoring Organization is presented at check-in. **Must have proof of Scramble Project.**

**8a. Classes: No heifers older than January 2012**

1. January 2014 and younger
2. Sept - Dec 2013
3. May – Aug 2013
4. Jan – Apr 2013
5. Sept – Dec 2012
6. May – Aug 2012
7. Jan – Apr 2012

8b. 3 head or less will constitutes a breed and will be shown as one class. Single entry classes will show in Champion Drive.

8c. Any class which is larger than can be comfortably shown in the arena will be divided and the top 4 – 7 heifers selected by the judge from each section will come back to be judged for overall placings.

9. O.R.B. (Other Registered Breeds). Any breed of heifers not listed above may be entered in the Junior O.R.B. show, if they are registered in the herdbook of their breed association and are considered a purebred heifer by that association. TCCA members will receive their breed points.

10. Any member wishing to participate in the AOB or ABC division **must secure a TJLA Certificate of Registry** from the TJLA office. All AOB and ABC heifer exhibitors must present the Certificate of Registry during heifer check in to show.

11. A champion showman will be chosen for each division (American, British, European) and presented an award in Show A.

12. Premiums and Awards - Show A only.

- a. Rosette for class winners
- b. Ribbons to places 2 – 5 in all classes
- c. Awards to all Breed and Reserve Champions
- d. Cash Premiums

**Cash Award of \$50.00** to Reserve Champion in Show A selected from the American Breeds

**Cash Award of \$50.00** to Reserve Grand Champion in Show A selected from the British Breeds.

**Cash Award of \$50.00** to Reserve Grand Champion in Show A selected from the European Breeds.

f. **Show B** – No awards, no premiums, no Overall Grand Champions. TCCA points show only.

**13. TCCA Points Show A**

- a. All breed and reserve champions will receive their points, if they wish not to compete in the overall champion drive. Participation will be at the exhibitor's discretion.
- b. If the grand of any breed does not stay for the championship drive, then the reserve champion of that breed may participate in the champion's place.

**14.** TCCA exhibitors must be in compliance with the rules stated in the TJLA rulebook to receive points.

**15.** The committee reserves the right to check any heifer tattoo at random.

**16.** Heifers will be released following their breed show.

**17.** No animals will be allowed to remain on the fairgrounds overnight after the show on Saturday.

2. Entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations, Code of Show Ring Ethics and all show rules of the Washington County Fair Association and the Texas Animal Health Commission.

**Health papers are required. Health paper is a general health certificate and must include the following: I.D. number of animal and statement of freedom from fevers and diseases.**

3. Entry cards and fees are due in the Fair Office by **September 1**. Entry fees: \$25.00 per steer for Show A: \$15.00 per steer for Show B. **Entry fees are non-refundable.**
- 3a. Late entries will be accepted at time of weigh-in on September 12 & 13. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged per steer, per show.
4. No pre-stalling of animals. (However, the show superintendent reserves the right to limit stall space to any exhibitor, 4-H Club or FFA Chapter.) **NO CATTLE TRIM CHUTES ALLOWED IN THE STALLING AREA OR IN THE BARN ISLES. CATTLE TRIM CHUTES MUST REMAIN OUTSIDE THE BARN.**
5. Exhibitors will receive one (1) gate pass and one (1) parking pass. A \$10.00 gate fee will be charged for all non-exhibitors. (Gate passes will be honored Friday and Saturday).

7. No shavings allowed in the barn. All animals will be stalled on sand.
8. No change of major pattern or materials glued to the animal's natural hair coat will be allowed. (Steer will be disqualified, show official's decision final.)
9. 3 head or less will constitutes a breed and will be shown as one class. Single entry classes will show in Champion Drive.
10. TCCA Points: In Show A, All breed and reserve breed champions will receive their points, if they wish not to compete in the overall champion drive. Participation will be at the exhibitor's discretion.
- 10b If the grand champion of any breed does not stay for the championship drive, then the reserve champion of that breed may participate in the champion's place.
11. TCCA exhibitors must be in compliance with all the rules as stated in the TJLA rulebook to receive show points.
12. The committee reserves the right to check any steer tag at random.
13. Cash premiums paid in Show A are based on number of entries shown per class. 1<sup>st</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup> place.

  - c. Award and Banner to Breed & Reserve Champions

  - e. **Cash award of \$50.00** to Overall Reserve Champion in Show A
15. A champion showman will be chosen for each division (American, British, European) and presented an award in Show A.
16. **Show B will have no awards, no premiums, no Overall Grand Champions. TCCA point show only.**
17. Steers will be released following their breed show.
18. No animals will be allowed to remain on the fairgrounds overnight after the show on Saturday.
