- **March 8th - Curstin**
  - Show buy-out's due by 4pm
  - Monthly Meeting at 4pm

  - Deadline for BFFA Show Exhibitors to meet their required Workday hours by 4pm

  - Cleaning, Mowing, Setting-up & preparing Farm for BFFA Show

  - **THESE ARE REQUIRED DATES FOR ALL EXHIBITORS**
- **March 25th - Madi**
  - Progress Reports for 5th 6 Weeks Grades Ends.
  - **IF YOU DID NOT PASS ALL CLASSES FOR THE 4TH 6 WEEKS THEN YOU MUST PASS ALL CLASSES FOR THE NEXT PROGRESS REPORT CYCLE TO BE ELIGIBLE TO SHOW**
  - Students **MUST** be academically eligible per UIL and HISD rules to exhibit and sell any project(s) at the 2022 Bellaire FFA Livestock Show.
  - \*Any student who fails a course (1) or multiple courses (more than 1) will be **INELIGIBLE** to show, compete, participate, etc. and **DOES NOT** have the option of a substitute exhibitor to show nor sell their project(s).
  - If you are not eligible to show then your animal **MUST** be removed prior to BFFA Show check in on Wednesday April 6, 2022.
  - If the animal is **NOT** removed by Wednesday April 6, 2022 the animal(s) will be taken to a local livestock auction facility and sold at auction value. If the animal was sponsored by a scramble or non-profit organization, any residual funds (after all outstanding dues and fees are paid) shall be returned to that organization. If the animal was not purchased by a scramble or non-profit organization, any residual funds (after outstanding dues and fees are paid) will be donated to the Bellaire FFA Chapter.

  - BFFA Show Deadline for Exhibitors to have participated in at least 2 different activities.
- **April 6-10 - Gabi**
  - Bellaire FFA Livestock Show & Auction

- **Minimum Weight requirements** - Gabi
  - Market Goats — no less than 70 lbs.
  - Market Swine — no less than 220 lbs.
  - Market Steers — no less than 1000 lbs
  - There are no maximum weight limits
